Methodist Healthcare Ministries of South Texas, Inc. is a private, faith-based, not-for-profit organization dedicated to creating access to health care for uninsured and low-income families through direct services, community partnerships and strategic grant-making in 74 counties across South Texas. Guided by its mission of "Serving Humanity to Honor God," Methodist Healthcare Ministries' vision is to be the leader for improving wellness of the least served.

Methodist Healthcare Ministries is committed to providing high quality, affordable care that is centered around each patient, providing support to make the best choices for their own health and well-being. We recognize that patients come to us seeking relief not only from physical conditions, but also healing from emotional and spiritual trauma. Using evidence-based practices, we listen carefully to each patient and offer integrated medical, behavioral and oral health care that is coordinated alongside parenting and wellness classes so that each patient has the opportunity to thrive.

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QUICK FACTS

- Methodist Healthcare Ministries owns and operates two primary care clinics in San Antonio (Wesley Health & Wellness Center; Dixon Health & Wellness Center).
- Methodist Healthcare Ministries provides pediatric medical care, dental care and counseling services to school-age children and their siblings (up to age 21) through its George Ricks School Based Health Centers in Schertz (Schertz Elementary).
- Methodist Healthcare Ministries' regional direct services include the Wesley Nurse Program; Community Health Workers or Promotores de Salud; Community Counseling Program; Prosperemos Juntos | Thriving Together (PJTT), Community Connectors, and Get FIT (Families in Training).
- Since inception, Methodist Healthcare Ministries has provided more than \$1.66 billion in health care services through its direct services, partnerships and strategic grant-making, and has the distinction of being one of the largest private funding sources of community health care to low-income families and the uninsured in South Texas.
- In 2025, Methodist Healthcare Ministries is projected to invest over \$62.5 million in community grants to more than 185 partners in Texas who address one of the following priority areas: access to care; mental and behavioral health; digital equity; food security; housing; education and workforce development.



SERVICE AREA

Methodist Healthcare Ministries shares a geographic footprint with the Rio Texas Conference of The United Methodist Church. Its service area however, is divided into regions based on where community members seek services such as health, social services and food, demographics and cultural history, and population density to ensure rural communities are factored in the size and distribution of resources.
