## ABOUT US

Methodist Healthcare Ministries of South Texas, Inc. is a private, faith-based, not-for-profit organization dedicated to creating access to health care for uninsured and low-income families through direct services, community partnerships and strategic grant-making in 74 counties across South Texas. Guided by its mission of "Serving Humanity to Honor God," Methodist Healthcare Ministries' vision is to be the leader for improving wellness of the least served.

Methodist Healthcare Ministries also works with similarly focused organizations and state government in developing more socially conscious public policy. The purpose is to change legislative perspectives and policies so that the root problems of the underserved are addressed for the long term.

## A UNIQUE MODEL

Since 1995, in joint partnership with HCA Healthcare, Methodist Healthcare Ministries has retained one-half ownership of the Methodist Healthcare System – the largest healthcare system in South Texas. This creates a unique avenue to ensure the Methodist Healthcare System continues to be a benefit to the community by providing quality care to all and charitable care when needed and provides revenue to Methodist Healthcare Ministries for its programs and services.



## JOINT PARTNERSHIP

Methodist Healthcare Ministries owns one-half of Methodist Healthcare System and maintains local governance.

## QUICK FACTS

- Methodist Healthcare Ministries owns and operates two primary care clinics in San Antonio (Wesley Health & Wellness Center; Dixon Health & Wellness Center).
- Methodist Healthcare Ministries provides pediatric medical care, dental care and counseling services to school-age children and their siblings (up to age 21) through two School Based Health Centers in Schertz and Marion (Schertz Elementary; Krueger Elementary).
- Methodist Healthcare Ministries' regional direct services include the Wesley Nurse Program; Community Health Workers or Promotores de Salud; Community Counseling Program; and Get FIT (Families in Training).
- Since inception, Methodist Healthcare Ministries has provided more than \$1.06 billion in health care services through its direct services, partnerships and strategic grant-making, and has the distinction of being one of the largest private funding sources of community health care to low-income families and the uninsured in South Texas.
- In 2020, Methodist Healthcare Ministries is expected to invest \$31.9 million in community grants to more than 90 partners in South Texas, and is estimated to impact more than 950,000 patients/clients through its programs and services, and through agencies it funds.

## SERVICE AREA

The Rio Texas Conference of The United Methodist Church defines Methodist Healthcare Ministries' 74-county service area in South Texas. Methodist Healthcare Ministries' service area makes up 29 percent of all counties in the state of Texas.
