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
### Project Objectives

- I. To quantify the current and future supply of Pediatric Subspecialists in the San Antonio MSA
  - Determine which Pediatric Subspecialties constitute a full spectrum of comprehensive care
  - Quantify existing and future supply of Pediatric Subspecialists including impact of retirements
- II. To calculate the current and projected Demand for Pediatric Subspecialists
  - Develop appropriate physician to population benchmarks for each Subspecialty
  - Apply benchmarks to current and future population to determine Physician Demand by Subspecialty
- III. To determine the gap between Supply and Demand for Pediatric Subspecialists
  - Identify which Subspecialties are either not provided or undersupplied in San Antonio thus requiring patients to seek care in other markets (i.e. outmigration) and/or reducing access to care
  - Estimate timing of required additions to supply of Pediatric Subspecialists


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### Process/Approach

- For most specialties, Physician Demand analysis can be based on population and age-specific use rates derived from the National Ambulatory Medical Care Survey (NAMCS), a comprehensive report published by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
- There are no available recommended Pediatric Subspecialist to population ratios which could be used as benchmarks/targets for San Antonio. Note that during the course of this project, the following organizations were researched on the internet and contacted via telephone, however none provide recommended benchmarks.
  - American Board of Pediatrics
  - American Academy of Pediatrics
  - American Pediatric Surgical Association
  - American Pediatric Society
  - Child Health Corporation of America (formerly NACHRI)
- Because there is insufficient data regarding Pediatric Subspecialists in the NAMCS report, the methodology for this project is based on an analysis of the ratio of physicians to population for Pediatric Subspecialists in markets that are reasonable proxies for the San Antonio MSA.
- Selected MSA's include Austin, Houston, and Dallas / Ft. Worth:
  - Each has significant established Children's Hospitals which provide a broad range of services
  - Each represents an MSA with a population exceeding 1,000,000 lives
  - Data is readily available and complete for Physician Supply, Inpatient Volumes, and Population

## I. Introduction

### *Physician Demand Analysis Approach*

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- Metropolitan Statistical Area: Defined by zip code 4 major MSA's in Texas
- Pediatric Population: Analyzed 2011, 2016, and 2021 Pediatric age (0 – 17) population of each MSA
- Pediatrics Physician Supply (Unadjusted): Determined existing supply of Pediatricians for each MSA
  - Subspecialists
  - Neonatology
  - Psychiatry
  - General Pediatrics
- Ratio Pediatricians to Population (Unadjusted): For each MSA, calculated ratio of Pediatrics Physiciansto Population by Specialty
- Immigration / Outmigration Factors: For each MSA, calculated the net Inmigration or Outmigration of inpatients in order to adjust the effective Ratio of Pediatricians to Population
- Pediatrics Physician Supply (Adjusted): By applying the Immigration / Outmigration factors, the effective Physician Supply was calculated for each MSA
- Benchmark Ratios of Pediatricians to Population (Adjusted): Revised ratios of Pediatricians to Population were calculated using the Adjusted Pediatric Physician Supply; a Benchmark Ratio was determined using the average ratios of Dallas / Ft. Worth, Houston, and Austin
- Required Physicians: Number of Pediatric Subspecialists was calculated by applying the Benchmark Ratio to the San Antonio MSA population
- Physician Surplus or Deficit: The differences between Supply and Required Physicians was calculated for 2011, 2016, and 2021 to determine the number and mix of Subspecialists required to meet the Benchmark Ratio

## I. Introduction

### *Population & Inpatient Volumes*

#### Population

- Pediatric population in the San Antonio MSA is projected to experience strong growth over the next five and ten year periods:
  - Strong percentage growth projected throughout MSA... highest increase in Bexar County
  - Over 16% growth in the San Antonio MSA (+95,000 lives) between 2011 and 2021

- There were nearly 14,000 Pediatric inpatient discharges from the San Antonio MSA in 2011 (excluding Neonatology and Psychiatric volumes)
- Assuming Use Rates remain constant, inpatient volumes should grow commensurate with population



### 2011 Pediatric Subspecialist Demand Analysis


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- Demand Analysis indicates a current deficit of approximately 20 Pediatric Subspecialists and 43 General Pediatricians in the San Antonio MSA... this deficit is expected to increase substantially in the coming years due to physician retirements and increased demand (see following pages)
- Physician Surplus or Deficit calculations based on a quantitative analysis, however appear to be in agreement with general qualitative perceptions
- Subspecialties with a current deficit of at least 1.0 physicians include:
  - Allergy / Immunology
  - Anesthesiology
  - Cardiology
  - Endocrinology
  - Gastroenterology
  - Genetics
  - Hematology/Oncology
  - Infectious Diseases
  - Neurology
  - Psychiatry
  - Rheumatology
- Discrepancies between the quantitative model and qualitative perceptions may be due to:
  - Incorrect categorization of Pediatric Subspecialties in Benchmark MSA's
  - Adequate services provided by physicians not included in analysis (e.g. Radiology, Gynecology)
- Notes:
  - Table of Pediatric Subspecialists reflects the most current information available, however Physician Supply in any large market is subject to constant change due primarily to recruitment, relocations, and retirements.
  - Considerable overlap exists between patients treated by General Pediatrics and Family Practice physicians which were not analyzed as part of this project

## I. Introduction

### *Summary*

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- Note that the analysis contained in this report is necessarily high level in nature due to:
  - Lack of Definitive Recommended Pediatric Subspecialist to Population Benchmarks
  - Difficulties in Classification of Pediatricians by Subspecialty
  - Overlap of Physician Practice Patterns
  - Absence of Physician Productivity Data
- Despite these limitations, this analysis provides clear quantitative evidence of a need in the San Antonio MSA for additional Pediatric Subspecialists

## II. Pediatric Subspecialist Supply Analysis

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
### Process/Approach

- Researched and summarized the full spectrum of Pediatric Subspecialists that are provided at leading Children's Hospitals across the United States
  - All are "Top 10 Children's Hospitals" per US News & World Report
  - Conducted web-based research supplemented by telephone calls to develop list
- Determined Pediatric Subspecialists practicing in the San Antonio MSA... sources included:
  - Texas Board of Medical Examiners (BOMEX)
  - Methodist Healthcare System Database
  - Internet/Website Research
- Reviewed preliminary list of Pediatric Subspecialists incorporating:
  - Actual vs. Listed Subspecialty
  - Recent or Planned Relocations
  - Full Time Equivalent (FTE) Estimates

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#### **Objectives**

- To identify Pediatric Subspecialties that would constitute a complete spectrum of care

#### **Process**

- Conducted website and telephone research of Pediatric Subspecialists practicing at leading Children's Hospitals across the country
- Assigned physicians listed as practicing at these Children's Hospitals into 33 consistent categories
- Note: Table indicates Pediatric Subspecialists, not clinical programs... the absence of Pediatric Subspecialists does not necessarily imply related services are not provided
- Applied Subspecialty groupings to Physician Supply in San Antonio as well as benchmark Metropolitan Statistical Areas (i.e. Dallas/Ft. Worth, Austin, and Houston)



### 2011 Pediatric Subspecialties – Physician Supply & Age Distribution<sup>(1)(2)</sup>



### 2011 Pediatric Subspecialties – Physician Supply & Age Distribution<sup>(1)(2)</sup>






## *2010 Methodist System Pediatric Discharges by Zip Code<sup>(1)</sup>*


*2010 Methodist System Pediatric Market Share by Zip Code<sup>(1)</sup>*


2010 CHRISTUS System Pediatric Discharges by Zip Code<sup>(1)</sup>


### 2010 CHRISTUS System Pediatric Market Share by Zip Code<sup>(1)</sup>


2010 Baptist System Pediatric Discharges by Zip Code<sup>(1)</sup>


### 2010 Baptist System Pediatric Market Share by Zip Code<sup>(1)</sup>


## *2010 University Health System Pediatric Discharges by Zip Code<sup>(1)</sup>*


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#### **Approach**

- Because the approach uses Physician to Population Ratios as a key metric, it is necessary to account for the Net Inmigration or Outmigration of patients served by the Pediatric Subspecialists
- Either the Population or Physician Supply can be adjusted, however only the latter can be meaningfully modified
- To do so, for all MSA's an Adjustment Factor was developed to account for the net Inmigration or Outmigration of patient volumes
- The Adjustment Factors are applied to the Physician Supply to calculate the effective Physician to Population Ratios in each MSA
- A comparison of the Adjusted Physician to Population Ratios was made for San Antonio, Houston, Austin, and Dallas / Ft. Worth
- The average Ratios of the Houston, Austin, and Dallas / Ft. Worth MSA's were used as a proxy Benchmark Ratio for purposes of this analysis
















#### 2011 San Antonio MSA Population Distribution by Age Cohort<sup>(1)</sup>


#### Percent Growth by Age Cohort 2011 to 2016<sup>(1)</sup>


#### 2011 Total Population<sup>(1)</sup>



Percentage Total Population Growth 2011 - 2016<sup>(1)</sup>





#### Absolute Total Population Growth 2011 - 2016<sup>(1)</sup>




*Absolute 0 - 17 Population Growth 2010 - 2015<sup>(1)</sup>*

#### 2011 Median Household Income<sup>(1)</sup>



#### 2011 Median Household Income % Above or Below Bexar County Average <sup>(1)</sup>




#### 2011 – 2016 Median Household Income<sup>(1)</sup>

### 2011 Physician Demand Analysis

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- Demand Analysis indicates a current deficit of approximately 20 Pediatric Subspecialists and 43 General Pediatricians in the San Antonio MSA... this deficit is expected to increase substantially in the coming years due to physician retirements and increased demand (see following pages)
- Physician Surplus or Deficit calculations based on a quantitative analysis, however appear to be in agreement with general qualitative perceptions
- Subspecialties with a current deficit of at least 1.0 physicians include:
  - Allergy / Immunology
  - Anesthesiology
  - Cardiology
  - Endocrinology
  - Gastroenterology
  - Genetics
  - Hematology/Oncology
  - Infectious Diseases
  - Neurology
  - Psychiatry
  - Rheumatology
- Discrepancies between the quantitative model and qualitative perceptions may be due to:
  - Incorrect categorization of Pediatric Subspecialties in Benchmark MSA's
  - Adequate services provided by physicians not included in analysis (e.g. Radiology, Gynecology)
- Notes:
  - Table of Pediatric Subspecialists reflects the most current information available, however Physician Supply in any large market is subject to constant change due primarily to recruitment, relocations, and retirements.
  - Considerable overlap exists between patients treated by General Pediatrics and Family Practice physicians which were not analyzed as part of this project





2011 Total Population<sup>(1)</sup>






#### 2011 0 - 17 Population<sup>(1)</sup>


Percentage Total Population Growth 2011 - 2016<sup>(1)</sup>


Percentage 0 - 17 Population Growth 2011 - 2016<sup>(1)</sup>


Absolute Total Population Growth 2011 - 2016<sup>(1)</sup>

Absolute 0 - 17 Population Growth 2011 - 2016<sup>(1)</sup>






#### 2011 Median Household Income<sup>(1)</sup>
